**P (UK) NEWCOMERS ZENITH CHAMPIONSHIP – ONE PHASE
ONLY**

Open Working Horse/Pony, stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Riders any age. Minimum height of fences 60cm (2 ft.) and maximum height of fences 92cm (3 ft.) These classes are designed to encourage the horse/pony and rider to perform stylishly.

Method of Judging; ... see over

- A. Horses / Ponies will enter the ring individually and jump a course of obstacles designed to produce a maximum of 10 jumping efforts. Course Builders are recommended to avoid fences with a related distance.
- B. Each jumping effort will be marked out of 10 – at the Judges discretion.
- C. There is no set penalty for a pole down or run out, but three refusals will result in elimination.
- D. Fall of horse or rider will result in elimination.
- E. There will be no mark awarded for conformation or manners, but a mark will be awarded for overall impression at the completion of each round. – maximum 20 marks.
- F. In the event of a tie, the overall impression mark will determine the final placings. Should there still be an equality of marks, the jumping marks will be taken into consideration – the comparison beginning with fence one and continuing thereafter until a result is achieved. Classes will be divided as follows;

HORSE & PONY SHOW RULES

1. The judge's decision is final.
2. PONIES (U.K.), & B.S.P.S qualifying classes will be judged under their rules. All ponies to be registered with their respective Breed Societies. Entries for M&M will not be accepted unless registration numbers are shown on the entry form.
3. Classes will be divided at the discretion of the judge.
4. INSURANCE: Gorefield Show Committee cannot accept liability howsoever caused by an individual, animal or vehicle. Gorefield Show Committee strongly advise all participants/riders have up to date third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in all events, equestrian or other wise, and all vehicles.
5. Any objection must be made within 15 minutes of the end of the class, in writing and accompanied by £20, returnable if the objection is upheld. Objections will not be entertained otherwise.
6. Competitors must wear correct riding clothes, hard hats to the approved B.S.I. Standard.
7. All ponies in ridden classes must be 4 years old or over.
8. No rider may carry, use or permit to be used, a whip exceeding 30" in length.
9. Age as at 1st Jan 2009.
10. Classes will not be held up on the day.
11. In all P.U.K. & B.S.P.S. Classes a 1st prize money only will be awarded if less than 3 entries per class. 1st & 2nd prize money only will be awarded if less than 6 entries per class.
12. The Committee would appreciate entries before the close of previous class.
13. Horses & ponies are not allowed to be ridden other than at WALK except in the rings & working in area.
14. No lunging due to limited space & health and safety regs.
15. Refunds only for classes that clash.
16. A Deposit of £20 to be paid before collection of trophies.
17. Dogs MUST be kept on leads at all times.
18. The committee reserves the right to make changes to scheduled classes without prior notice.
19. Short, dark, waterproof jackets only can be worn in the ring in wet conditions.

The highest placed pony in the Heritage Open Lead Rein, First Ridden, Ridden and WHP classes, which has not qualified for the BSPS 2009 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class, will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the BSPS Challenge, the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony.

This Show is a qualifier for The B.S.P.S. BLACK COUNTRY SADDLES Best Rider of The Year.

The best rider in the Nursery & Cradle Stakes, Open Heritage Lead Rein, First Ridden and to the best rider 25 years and under in The Heritage Ridden and WHP Classes will receive a Card and qualify for the final at The B.S.P.S. Summer Championship Show.

B.S.P.S. Classes: - Ponies must be registered before the date of the show at which they qualify for the B.S.P.S. Summer Championships, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies.

“This Show is affiliated to The British Show Pony Society (“B.S.P.S.”) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in B.S.P.S. classes, whether or not members of B.S.P.S. are subject to the Rules of the B.S.P.S., including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S.”

This show is a qualifier for Ponies (UK) 2009 Summer Championship Show to be held on 12-15th August 2009 at the Newark & Notts. showground.

For P(UK) Qualifiers, the 1st, 2nd, & 3rd in each Qualifying Class will qualify.

No qualification cards will be awarded in the ring, placings will be confirmed by results sent in by the show secretary.

Qualification for Summer National Championships

1st, 2nd & 3rd placed horses/ponies in all Summer National Championships will qualify for the 2009 P (UK) Summer National Championships.

Results must be submitted to the Ponies (UK) offices within 14 days of the qualifying show with the exception of shows being held between 5th July and 26th July need to submit their results within 48 hours after the qualifying event.

Qualification cards will not be presented in the ring.

Competitors in qualifying positions, who are ***not*** current members of P (UK) are allowed ***14 days*** in which to become members and register their horses/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid. The exception being any competitor qualifying at a show between 5th July and 26th July must submit their membership within 48 hours after the qualifying event in order for the qualification to remain valid.

This Show is a qualifier for The P (UK) 2009 Pollyanna Home Produced Championships.

These classes are open to Horses & Ponies that have been stabled at home since 1st August 2008. DIY livery is acceptable providing it is not the establishment of a professional show producer/trainer. Horses/ponies entering these championships must be owned, produced, ridden or led by the owner/spouse or his/her son/daughter/grandchild.

It is expected that exhibitors will enter into the true spirit of this competition.

The Directors reserve the right in, their absolute discretion, to refuse an exhibitors entry should they be in contravention of this rule, in the Directors considered opinion.

1st, 2nd & 3rd placed ponies/horses in all 2009 Summer Pollyanna Home Produced Qualifiers will qualify for the 2009 P (UK) Summer Championships.

Qualification cards will not be presented in the ring.

ALL RIDERS/HANDLERS MUST APPLY TO BECOME EITHER JUNIOR/SENIOR RIDERS CLUB MEMBERS WITHIN 14 DAYS OF QUALIFYING IN ORDER FOR THE QUALIFICATION FOR THE SUMMER POLLYANNA CHAMPIONSHIPS TO REMAIN VALID.
