Schools – PCSO's have been attending schools in the Wisbech and Rural areas on a regular basis

Theft of Garden ornaments – Garden ornaments are an easy target for thieves who often work during the hours of darkness, it is most probably that a van or lorry is used to transport the items away. Photographs of garden ornaments are useful in the event of a theft to help identify any stolen items. It is well worth marking ornaments on their bases with a post code and house number. If possible ornaments should be secured to make it harder for would be thieves.

116/15 MATTERS ARISING ON THE AGENDA

(1) **Highway Matters**

The poor condition of Churchill Road carriageway surface was again reported to Highway officer Steve Nicholson. He responded by saying that the carriageway is scabby and not very aesthetically pleasing and is due to the surface dressing coming away from the concrete road underneath. There are no defects which meet the current intervention level.

A copy of this was sent to the resident of Churchill Road who had brought this to the attention of the Council.

An application has been submitted for the Local Highway Improvement Initiative 2016/17. Following on from several e-mails with Matthew Pickering the application is to move the 30mph zone further along Wolf Lane towards where the Gorefield sign is. The application also includes making a gated entrance with 30mph signs.

(2) Play Equipment

No inspection reports have been received recently but the inspector has been seen carrying out the inspections. The zip wire is now back in place.

(3) Streetlights

Skanska should be undertaking the survey of the streetlights for 7 Parish Council shortly. Following on from their report the Chairman of Doddington PC would like to call another meeting and Councillor King has expressed his willingness to attend one of the meetings.
